## Good Centrifuge Practise

## Centrifuges can be potentially dangerous, therefore it is vital that they are properly maintained and used correctly.

- 1. Always run with a full compliment of buckets, failure to do so can distort rotor.
- 2. Ensure the rotor and all lids are tightened correctly before use.
- Only use accessories intended for use in your particular centrifuge, as recommended by your centrifuge supplier.
- 4. Balance accessories and samples to within less than 2 gms per bucket.
- 5. Samples should be diametrically distributed evenly around the buckets as shown.
- 6. Clean and lubricate rotor pins monthly.
- 7. High strength aluminium corrodes easily, to prevent this, remove adaptors and keep buckets clean and dry at all times.
- 8. Only clean aluminium buckets in a neutral ph cleaner. Do not use strong alkalis, acids or chloros.
- 9. Condensation build up in a centrifuge bowl will damage the motor and buckets. Allow this to evaporate by leaving the lid open at night with power switched off.
